Pre-Anesthetic Labwork/Fluid Therapy/Pain Management

Whenever an animal undergoes anesthesia/sedation and surgery, some risk is involved. The amount of risk depends on many factors including age, physical condition and the condition of organ systems (heart, kidney, liver, etc.). Anesthetic risks can be greatly reduced, but not eliminated, with prior knowledge obtained through blood testing. All patients will receive a complete physical exam prior to any anesthesia or sedation, but we also recommend the following testing:

- Basic Testing (CBC, Minimum Chemistry) Recommended for puppy/kitten to 7 years. \$53.50
- Advanced Testing (CBC, Comprehensive Chemistry) Recommended for pets over 7 years. \$63.50
- Electrocardiogram (EKG) to screen for heart conditions that can lead to anesthesia complications. \$29.50
- I choose to decline all testing at the time and authorize you to proceed with anesthesia/surgery.

- **Intravenous Fluid Therapy** (subcutaneous fluids in some patients) will be administered to all patients while under anesthesia to minimize the effects of the anesthetic drugs (low blood pressure, slowed metabolism).
- Patients undergoing surgical procedures experience pain. **Pain management** is not only humane, but allows your pet to heal faster and prevents the potential medical complications associated with uncontrolled pain. We will administer and prescribe pain medication for your pet as deemed necessary.
